MTI Bargaining & Handbook Committees To Reconvene This Week

The MTI Bargaining and Handbook teams (Teacher, ESEA and Subs) meet Friday, July 12 to discuss next steps in base-wage bargaining and review member survey feedback on Employee Handbook review.

The bargaining team will also be discussing additional opportunities and actions to recommend to MTI members in support of their bargaining team as base-wage bargaining continues next week.

It's Far From Over...

Base-wage bargaining between MTI and the MMSD will resume next week following Governor Ever's signing of the State Budget (which included additional funding for public schools). MTI and the Building Trade unions continue to seek a 2.44% cost-of-living base-wage increase.

Lots of changes in MMSD Leadership

Following Superintendent Cheatham's resignation, former MMSD Administrator, Jane Belmore, has been appointed to serve as Interim Superintendent.

BOE member Mary Burke has resigned from the Board of Education (BOE). The BOE will need to appoint an "interim" BOE member, prior to conducting an election next spring to fill the seat.

All MTI members will continue to receive updates as base-wage bargaining progresses and Employee Handbook discussions get underway.
