



MTI 2019-20 Bargaining Update

Base-wage Bargaining Resumes Wednesday, 7/17/2019

The MTI Bargaining Teams (Teacher, ESEA, and Substitutes), joined by the Building Trades Unions and AFSCME Local 60 (Custodians and Food Service Workers) representatives, will resume base-wage negotiations with the Madison Metropolitan School District tomorrow, Wednesday, July 17. Negotiations had been suspended last month pending the resolution of the State Budget given its impact on school district revenues. MTI and its partner unions have been demanding a cost-of-living 2.44% base-wage increase for all employees. The District has been offering a 0.5% base-wage increase.

With the State Budget now resolved, and with the additional revenue provided the MMSD, we expect to see movement by the District toward meeting the unions demand for a cost-of-living base-wage increase for all employees.
