Base-wage Bargaining Heads to Mediation

As we advised last week, base-wage bargaining hit an impasse with the District now offering a 2.32% increase, MTI and its union partners demanding a 2.44% cost-of-living increase, and neither party currently willing to move off of those proposals. Given the bargaining impasse, the parties are now requesting the services of a mediator to assist with the negotiations in hopes of reaching a mutually agreeable resolution. We hope to schedule mediation in early August and will send all MTI members updates as bargaining continues.

All staff members received an e-mail message from Superintendent Cheatham earlier this week which outlines the District's most recent proposal.
