MTI Names Edward Sadlowski as next Executive Director

TODAY, Madison Teachers Inc. (MTI) is excited to announce the hiring of Edward Sadlowski as Executive Director of the second largest public educator union in Wisconsin. Sadlowski's hiring came after a comprehensive search where MTI leadership sought candidates who would help guide the union in its continued evolution in post Act 10 Wisconsin. Sadlowski is a fourth-generation trade unionist who has worked with both private and public sector unions for over 30 years including a 14-year period (1993-2007) when he worked as a staff representative for MTI. He most recently worked as Deputy Director for the Milwaukee Teachers Education Association.

Sادلowski will be MTI's third Executive Director in its over 50-year history. He will replace current Executive Director, Doug Keillor, who will be retiring from MTI on June 30 after nearly 30 years with MTI. Keillor replaced John Matthews who retired in 2016. Sadlowski will begin his work with MTI on June 1, 2020 and will work closely with Keillor until the end of June when Keillor's contract with MTI ends.

MTI is a member-led organization that represents about 3,000 employees of the Madison Metropolitan School District. The union has maintained a strong voice on wages, benefits, and working conditions while advocating on issues of racial and social justice.

"We are happy to welcome Ed back to MTI," said MTI President Andy Waity. "Sادلowski's experience as an organizer and advocate will provide a strong foundation to continue the work our members are engaged in."
